

# Information for Authors

The *International Journal of MS Care* (IJMSC) publishes peer-reviewed clinical and original research articles and occasional reviews and case studies in areas of interest to multiple sclerosis (MS) health care professionals. Topics include medical, nursing, rehabilitative, psychological, and psychosocial care of people with MS and reflect the diversity of the journal's readership.

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

**Submissions.** Health care professionals are invited to submit articles, case studies, and reviews of topics of interest to the MS professional community. Submissions should follow the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals ([www.icmje.org](http://www.icmje.org)). Manuscripts, including disclosure information, should be sent via e-mail as attachments to [IJMSC@mscare.org](mailto:IJMSC@mscare.org). Questions regarding the suitability or status of a submission should be sent to Maria Stadler or Dr. Lael Stone at the same email address.

**Authorship.** Individuals designated as authors must 1) contribute to the conception and design or analysis and interpretation of data, 2) draft or critically revise the article for important content, AND 3) approve the final version. Authors or other contributors who do not meet all three criteria should be recognized in an acknowledgment.

**Disclosures/conflicts of interest.** Disclosure forms are available at [www.mscare.org/cmsc/images/pdf/ijmsc\\_author\\_disclosure.pdf](http://www.mscare.org/cmsc/images/pdf/ijmsc_author_disclosure.pdf). Forms should accompany manuscript submissions and may be submitted electronically or by fax to 216-445-6259, attn Maria Stadler. Authors must disclose all relationships (financial and non-financial) that could be viewed as conflicts of interest (for clarification, see [www.icmje.org/#conflict](http://www.icmje.org/#conflict)). Manuscripts will be sent for peer review after disclosures have been received for all authors.

## MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

Manuscripts should include a title page, abstract, text, references, and graphics, if applicable. All elements of the manuscript should be typed, double spaced, in MS Word. Refer to the *American Medical Association Manual of Style*, 10th ed. (AMA) (Williams & Wilkins, 2007) for guidelines. Do not use formatting of any kind nor headers, footers, or endnotes. Reference citations should *not* be linked to reference lists, and references should not be linked to the Internet.

All human investigation must be conducted according to the principles expressed in the Declaration of Helsinki (1975, as revised in 2000). All studies involving animals must state that guidelines for the use and care of laboratory animals of the authors' institution or the National Research Council or any national law were followed.

**Title page.** Include article title; full name and highest degree of each author; name and location of departments and institutions with which each author is affiliated (in English); and name, address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address of the corresponding author.

**Key words.** Authors should include 3–5 keywords for indexing.

**Abstract.** Summarize the content of the paper in 200 words or fewer. The abstract should be understandable without reference to the text and should not contain references.

**References.** References should be numbered consecutively. Recent references (within the past 5 years) are preferred. Follow AMA style guidelines. Examples:

*Journal*—Author SW, Author K, Author ER, et al. Article title. *J Title*. 1992;27:1893–1898.

*Supplement*—Author DR. Article title. *Int J MS Care*. 2006; 8(suppl 1):13–20.

*Book*—Author J, Author C, Author L. Chapter title. In: Editor J, ed. *Book Title*. Publisher City, State: Publisher Name; 2001:175–212.

*Electronic publication*—US Department of Agriculture. *Food Guide Pyramid 1992*. Available at: [fnic.nal.usda.gov/nal](http://fnic.nal.usda.gov/nal). Accessed 15 April 2007.

*Meeting abstract*—Author DP, Author CM, Author MA, et al. Abstract (or poster or presentation) title. Program and abstracts of the 40th Annual Meeting of the American Society of Clinical Oncology; 5–8 June 2004; New Orleans, LA. Abstract X.

**Graphics.** Tables and figures should be submitted on separate pages at the end of the manuscript. Each graphic should be numbered and titled and be accompanied by a descriptive legend. Line, bar, and pie charts should be created in an editable format, preferably Excel (including data tables used to create the figures). For best reproducibility, photos should be submitted as separate 300-dpi files (preferably jpeg or gif).

All graphics reprinted from other publications should be accompanied by a complete citation of the source. Written permission to reprint graphics must be obtained by the author from the copyright owner and forwarded to the journal office.

## PEER REVIEW

Submissions are sent for peer review to content experts in the particular area of the submitted article. Authors should suggest two or three potential reviewers for their manuscript. Reviewers recommend that a manuscript be accepted, rejected, or revised and include comments for the editor and reviewers. Final decisions are made by the editor in chief. The corresponding authors are notified of the final decision by email.

## COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT

Articles appearing in IJMSC are copyrighted by the Consortium of Multiple Sclerosis Centers. All accepted manuscripts become the sole permanent property of the Consortium of Multiple Sclerosis Centers and may not be published elsewhere without written permission from the publisher. On acceptance of the manuscript, a copyright assignment letter is sent to the corresponding author, who is responsible for ensuring that all authors sign and return the copyright form. Articles will not be published without a signed copyright release from all authors. Transfer of copyright implies transfer of rights for printed, electronic, microfilm, and facsimile publication.

**Reuse.** Authors are permitted to reuse portions of their copyrighted work, including tables and figures, in their own work and to reuse portions or all of their copyrighted work for educational purposes without submitting a request to the publisher, provided the proper citation and copyright information are given.

Permission requests to reproduce material from IJMSC in any other capacity should be sent to the publisher. Letters requesting permission should include the issue and page number on which the material appears and the name of the publication in which the material will be reproduced.

## COPYEDITING

All manuscripts are edited for clarity, style, conciseness, and format according to AMA guidelines. The edited manuscript is sent to the corresponding author, who will then answer any queries and approve the edited version for publication. The corresponding author is responsible for communicating with coauthors.
