Supporting PARENTS

- ✿ **Kids Get MS Too: A Guide for Parents Whose Child or Teen has MS (French and English)**
 - handbook containing a wide range of information on pediatric MS, written written by specialists in childhood MS
- ✿ **Teleconferences for parents** of children with MS
 - introduce families to specialists working in the field of childhood MS: research, treatment, cognitive issues, etc.
- ✿ **Email Group for Parents**
 - email list serve group where parents can share concerns and information, and develop a support network
- ✿ **Information and referral**
 - local resources, info on pediatric MS and MS in general, web resources

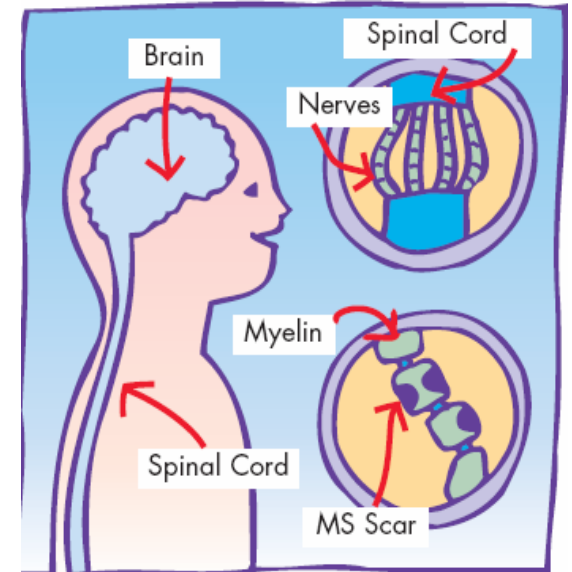

Connecting **TEENS**: Ithink...

✿ **Email Group for Teens with MS**

- moderated email group that allows teens to "meet" other teens, share concerns and information, and develop a support network

✿ **Telephone Support Group for Teens**

- a time-limited telephone moderated support group for teens with MS
- provides teens with a safe environment to share thoughts and concerns about living with MS (not a counseling group)
- lead by a young person with MS

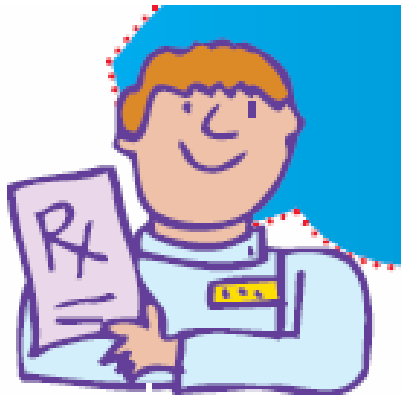
